

## Finding full-text papers using a reference management software

If you use Citavi, Zotero, EndNote or some other reference management software, you can export all your relevant references from EPPI Reviewer and then import them into a new library in Zotero, EndNote, etc.

You can then find the full papers from there in one step.

([Zotero](#) and [Citavi](#) are free. Many institutions, particularly academic institutions such as [UCL](#), have a staff & student license for EndNote.)

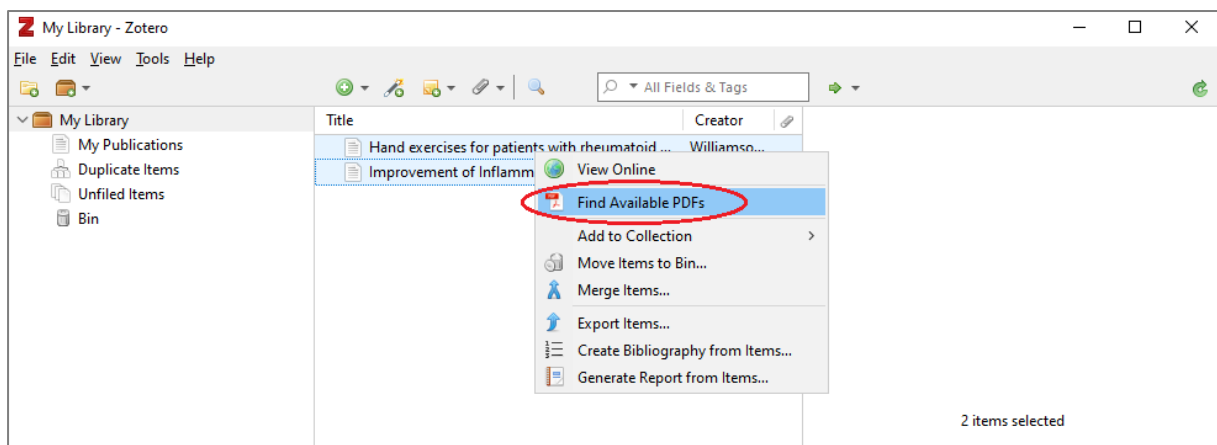
Once you have your refs imported into Zotero, EndNote or similar, you can find full text papers – but make sure you are connected to your institution’s network or resources.

*(If you are on a UCL machine (or connected to the UCL VPN / logged in to UCL library resources), you should be able to log in to UCL’s library resources. See <https://www.ucl.ac.uk/isd/services/get-connected/ucl-virtual-privatenetwork-vpn> for further details of connecting to the UCL VPN.)*

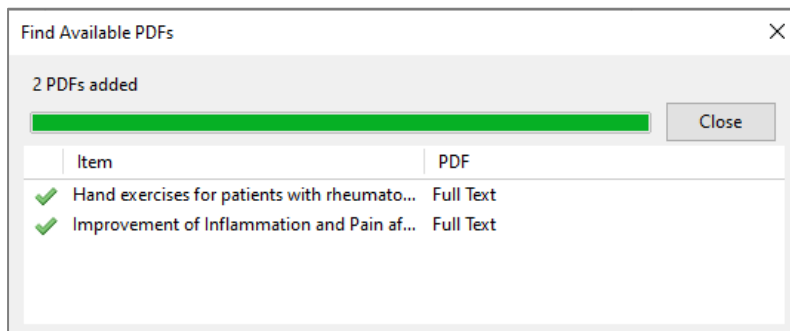

## Zotero

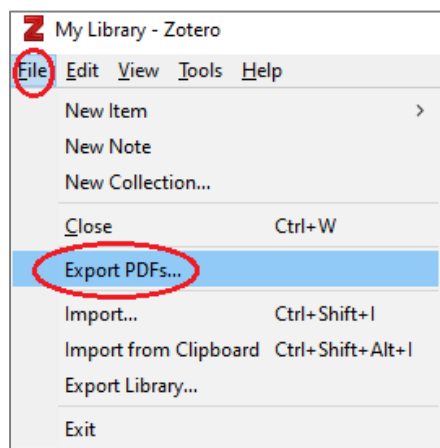
In Zotero, select the relevant papers and right-click. Select ‘**Find Available PDFs**’ from the menu that appears.



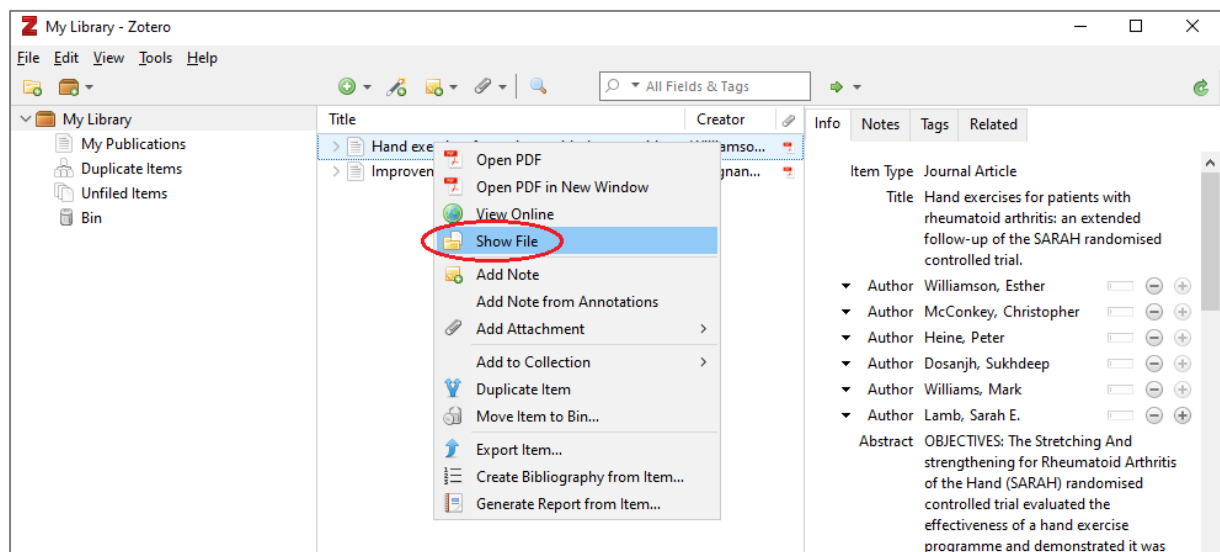
Zotero will search online for the full-text papers.



You can then export the found PDFs via the **File** menu.

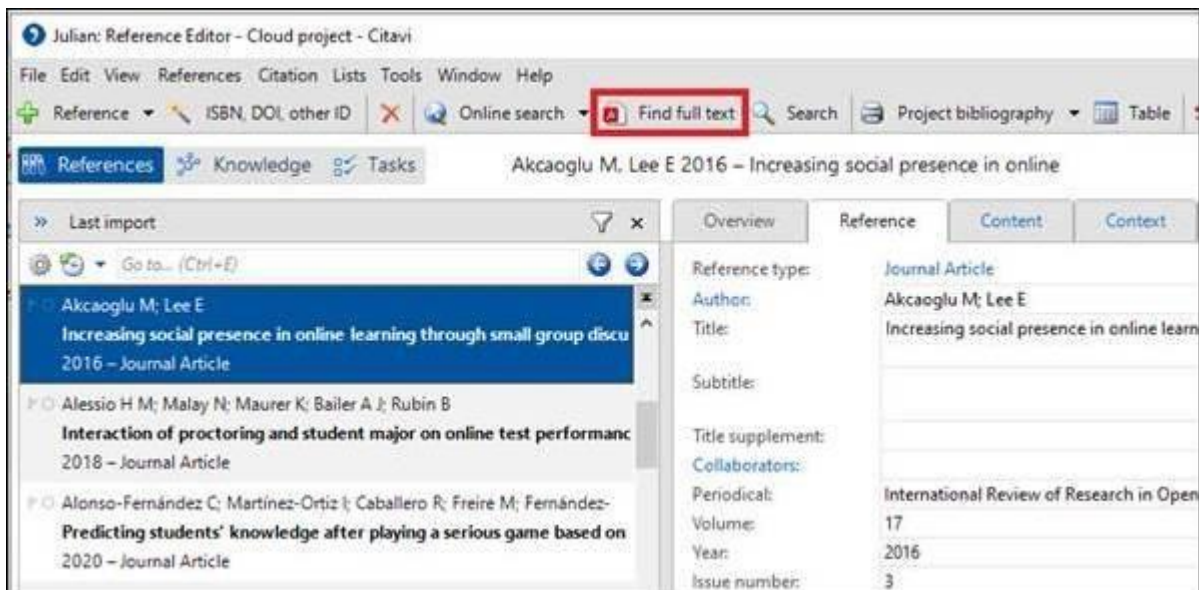


Or right-click on any of your refs and select the **Show File** option.

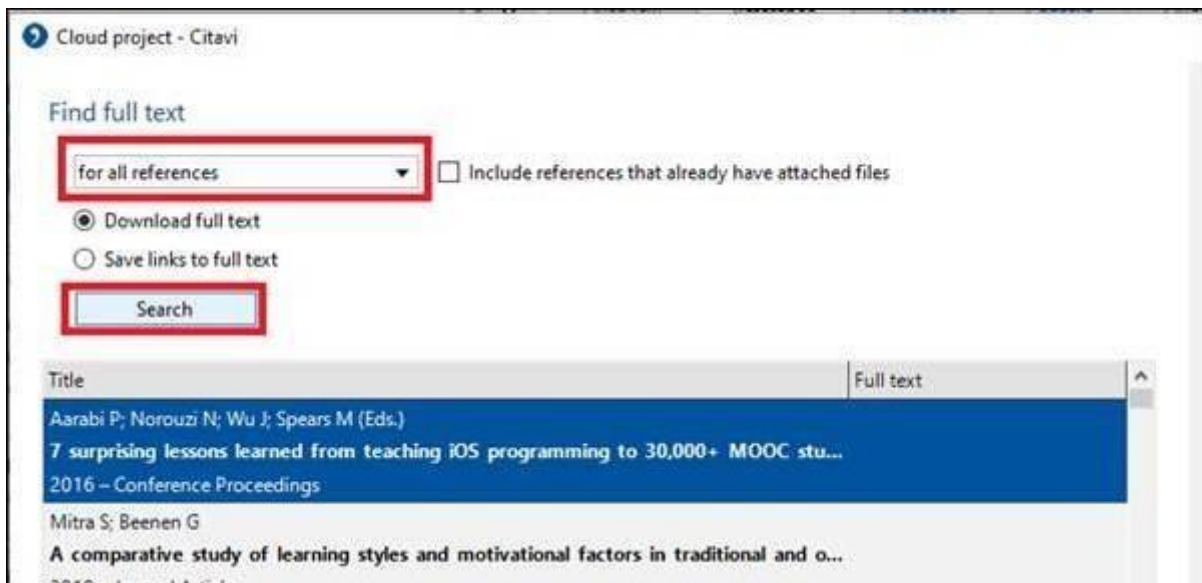


## Endnote

In EndNote, click on '**Find Full Text**'.



Select '**For all references**' and click on '**Search**'.

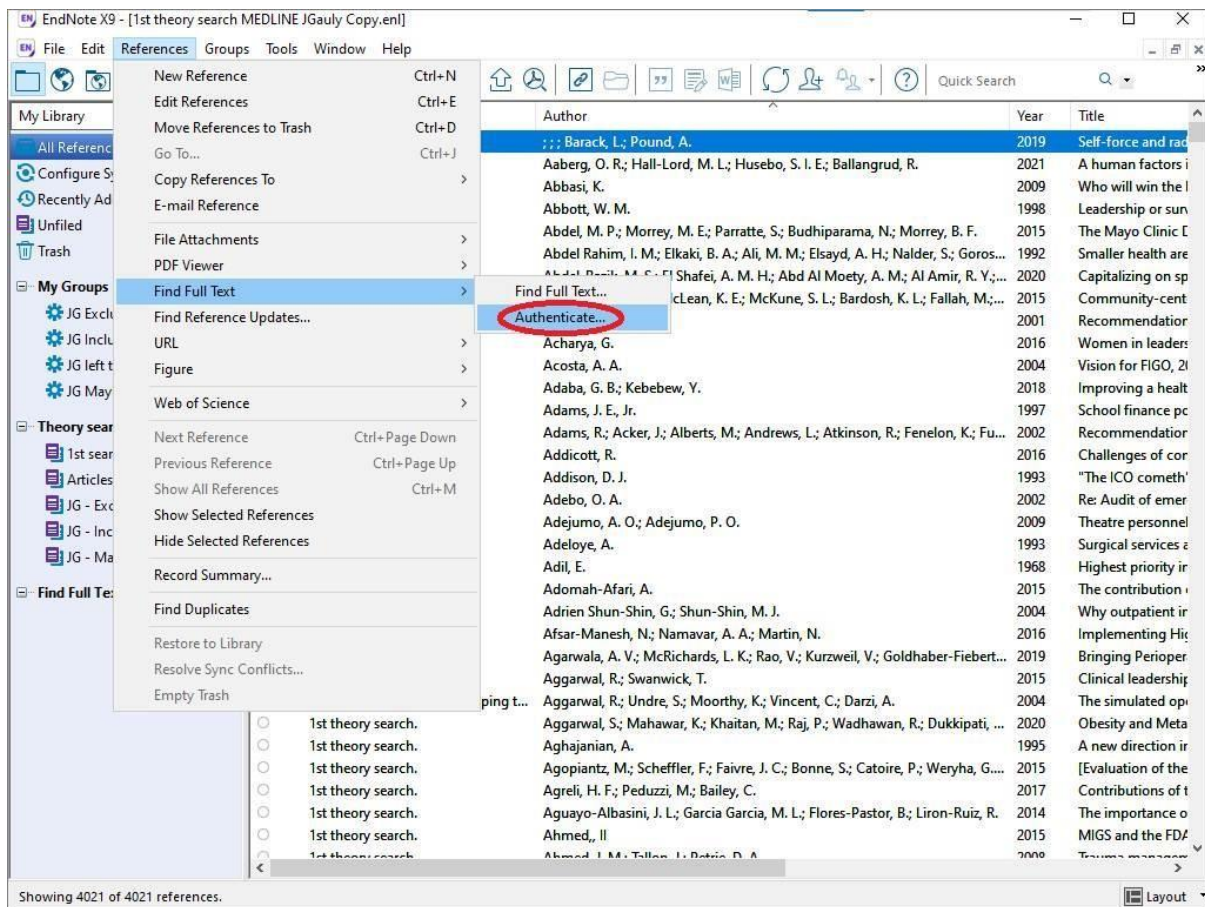


The program will use your institutional subscriptions to locate as many full texts as possible. Click on **'Add'** and it will upload them into the records for you. You will then have the full papers, which you can upload to EPPI Reviewer references on an individual basis. (Or copy the abstracts across on a per reference basis.)
